
Anei anō ngā mihi ki ā tātou kaiako mō ā rātou mahi whakatinana i tēnei kaupapa, ahakoa i ua nui i te mutunga o te rā. E mōhio ana mātou he mea nui te tautoko a te whānau whānui me ā tātou kaiako kia whakakotahi ai ngā kaupapa pēnei mō ā tātou tamariki. Ka nui te mihi, ka nui te aroha.

I tērā wāhanga i waimarie mātou ki te whiwhi pūtea tautoko nō Tū Manawa, ā, nā reira i taea ai e mātou te hoko taputapu mō te whakangungu ā-ropu me ngā hākinakina whānui hoki. Ko te aro matua, he hākinakina pōro. Kua taea ināianei te whakarite he whakangungu ā-ropu ki Hui-te-ana-nui, hei painga mō ā tātou tamariki o te Kura Nui. Waimarie tonu mātou ki te whakarato i ngā akoranga poitūkohu ki te Tari Taiwhanga ā-Rohe mō te rua o ngā rā ia wiki tae noa mai ki tēnei wā. Ko te tūmanako, ka noho ēnei hei wāhanga mauroa o tā tātou maramataka hei whakamahi i ngā rauemi o tō tātou hapori, hei whakatairanga hoki i te hākinakina hei tētahi o ā tātou aronga matua.

# IMPORTANT INFORMATION

**KIA MATAAHU**

Kia ora e te whānau whānui

He manako ia e ora pai ana te wīkene roa. He pānui tēnei e hāngai ana ki te tūkanga whanonga patu. After some discussions e te iwi, we will be re-enacting the kaupapa we had set before with regard to tamariki hitting others.

What does it mean when we say "he tapu te tinana"? An ongoing wānanga for us all, however, we have considered what that means for the following and that there will be zero tolerance.

1. Tamaiti hits another (punch, slap, scratch and/or push)
2. Tamaiti will be sent to the tari. Pou to manage.
3. Pou (in the tari) will phone home and explain the circumstance.
4. Mātua will be required to come and collect their tamaiti.
5. Kaiako will write the incident report and email home to explain the circumstances.
6. Kaiako and Pou to organise a hui with whānau, which will happen before our tamaiti returns to kura.
7. Tikanga upon tamaiti return: 2-3 days of break-time will be spent in the tari and/or whakapai whenua and/or loss of privileges for haerenga
8. Repeat behaviour second time: go to 1 then break-time days will increase 4-5
9. Repeat behaviour third time: Hui with Tumuaki and whānau to determine next steps.

This will begin Wednesday 4 June 2025.



- **Cell phones are NOT permitted at Kura. If for emergency reasons your tamaiti has a cell phone, they MUST hand into the tari in the mornings.**
- **Tauira are not permitted to bring lollies, chocolate, fizzy drinks of any kind and chewing/bubblegum to kura. These food items will be confiscated.**
- **Tauira are not permitted to bring perfumes, hairsprays, spray deodorants to Kura. These items will be confiscated.**
- **If there are any concerns regarding bullying, please come into the kura to inform us and have a kōrero.**

## SMOKING

Please remember, even though you are in your vehicle, you are still on kura grounds. SMOKING and/or VAPING is not permitted. It is illegal to smoke or vape on any school grounds
