He kupu nō te Tumuaki

Wiki 8 - Mane, 24 Noema - 28 Noema 2025

Kua mimiti atu anō tētahi wiki, ā, ko tētahi atu kei te pā tata mai! Nau mai, haere mai ki te wiki 8 o tō tātou haerenga ako. E whakanuia ana e tātou te kaha o ngā ringa raupā, o ngā ngākau aroha o tō tātou whānau whānui e ū nei ki te oranga o ā tātou tamariki. He nui tō tātou waimarie i te tautoko ka rere mai i ngā mātua, i te whānau hoki — ahakoa he āwhina i ngā rā hākinakina, he haere ki ngā haerenga marau, he toro ki te marae, he whai wāhi rānei ki ngā kaupapa o te kura, mā te Poari, mā ngā hui ā-kura, mā ngā tikanga o te kāinga ako.

E mihi kau ana ki ēnei ringa me ēnei manawa e kawe nei i tō tātou kura kia rere tonu, kia ū tonu ki te ara o Te Aho Matua. E mōhio ana hoki tātou, he nui ngā mahi kei mua i te aroaro, ā, ka kawea ngātahi e tātou.

Ki-o-rahī...

He haerenga nui anō mō ā tātou tamariki me ā tātou kaimahi. I whakahaerehia te kēmu Ki-o-Rahi e te Kura o Nawton i Kirikiriroa i te Paraire kua hipa, hei wāhanga o te kaupapa Pātukitahi. He kaupapa tēnei mō ngā kura Māori o Waikato ki te whai wāhi ki tētahi rā hākinakina. He kaupapa e whakamānawa ana i te reo Māori me ūna tikanga mā roto i ngā hākinakina. Ka whai wātea ngā kura ki te whakahaere i tētahi, ā, ka tukuna ngā tono ki ngā kura Māori katoa e hiahia ana ki te whai wāhi. E tino whakapehapeha ana mātou ki ā tātou tamariki me ā tātou kaimahi mō te whakatutuki i te tūranga tuarua!

Hoki atu ki te Akomanga...

He tino waimarie ki ahau te hoki ki te akomanga ki tā Kura Nui taha, ā, ki te kawe i ētahi akoranga ki ā tātou ākonga. E pai ana ki ahau te noho i te akomanga me ā tātou ākonga, ā, ki te kite i ētahi tirohanga hou mō ā tātou tamariki. E mihi ana ki te tautoko i kawea mai e ā tātou kaimahi ki tēnei wheako, me ā tātou ākonga hoki i te mea kua pānuitia rātou ki ngā panonitanga maha o te wātaka. Ko te ngahau te kaupapa matua! Ko te ako he kaupapa taha — Wepua!

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

KIA MATAAHU

Kia ora e te whānau whānui

Te manako ia e ora pai ana te wīkene roa. He pānui tēnei e hāngai ana ki te tūkanga whanonga patu. After some discussions e te iwi, we will be re-enacting the kaupapa we had set before with regard to tamariki hitting others.

What does it mean when we say "he tapu te tinana"? An ongoing wānanga for us all, however, we have considered what that means for the following and that there will be zero tolerance.

1. Tamaiti hits another (punch, slap, scratch and/or push)
2. Tamaiti will be sent to the tari. Pou to manage.
3. Pou (in the tari) will phone home and explain the circumstance.
4. Mātua will be required to come and collect their tamaiti.
5. Kaiako will write the incident report and email home to explain the circumstances.
6. Kaiako and Pou to organise a hui with whānau, which will happen before our tamaiti returns to kura.
7. Tikanga upon tamaiti return: 2-3 days of break-time will be spent in the tari and/or whakapai whenua and/or loss of privileges for haerenga
8. Repeat behaviour second time: go to 1 then break-time days will increase 4-5
9. Repeat behaviour third time: Hui with Tumuaki and whānau to determine next steps.

This will begin Wednesday 4 June 2025.



- **Cell phones are NOT permitted at Kura. If for emergency reasons your tamaiti has a cell phone, they MUST hand into the tari in the mornings.**
- **Tauira are not permitted to bring lollies, chocolate, fizzy drinks of any kind and chewing/bubblegum to kura. These food items will be confiscated.**
- **Tauira are not permitted to bring perfumes, hairsprays, spray deodorants to Kura. These items will be confiscated.**
- **If there are any concerns regarding bullying, please come into the kura to inform us and have a kōrero.**

SMOKING

Please remember, even though you are in your vehicle, you are still on kura grounds.

SMOKING and/or VAPING is not permitted. It is illegal to smoke or vape on any school grounds.

Nangs are also prohibited.
